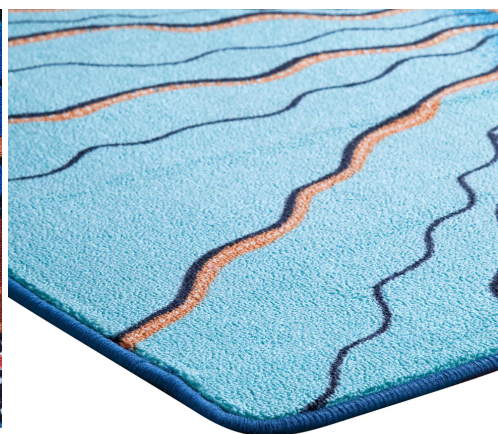
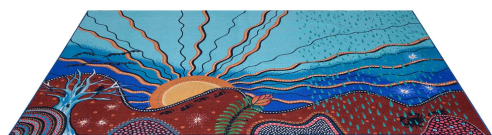

The importance of the seasons on Country, and the respect for each season held by First Nations people.

The Elizabeth Richards Indigenous Seasons Rug will become a central place in your classroom for sharing stories, holding yarning circles, reflecting on Indigenous histories and cultures, and learning the lessons of our First Nations people.

It is not only a unique piece of art but a functional classroom mat that can be used for setting up learning spaces and defining zones.
